



## Induction

- Remember the 4 steps to safety:
  - Is this a dangerous situation?
  - Are there tools or equipment here which is dangerous?
  - Are there people doing anything dangerous?
  - What am I going to do about it now?
- Be aware of the emergency protocol and procedures for PROPERTY. Locate list of emergency contact people, contact numbers, assembly points, location of the first aid and fire fighting equipment;
- Report ALL accidents/incidents, no matter how minor, to PROPERTY management;
- Be aware that most activities require Personal Protective Equipment (PPE); please make use of PPE when and where required;
- The PROPERTY is a hot area; care must be taken to avoid heat exhaustion;
- Switch off and unplug all non-essential electrical equipment after use;
- Do not litter, dispose of all waste in the correct bins;
- Use water sparingly.

## Vehicle Use and Transport

- Only appointed drivers with valid drivers and or operators permits/ licenses may operate designated vehicles and machinery on and off the PROPERTY;
- Only drivers with valid PDP may convey passengers and goods on a public road;
- Prior permission from management must be obtained should the vehicle be used off the PROPERTY and on public roads;
- Contractors and or official visitors (permission by prior arrangement with management) without appointed driver must comply with all applicable rules to driving vehicles on the PROPERTY;
- Speed limit on all roads is **40km/h**. Adjust speed according to road conditions;
- Only 1 front seat passenger allowed, unless vehicle allows more;

- One passenger per seat on a multi seat/game drive vehicle;
- Maximum of 4 passengers seated on truck floors. No passengers allowed to be transported with goods.
- All tools and equipment must be securely fastened and it is the driver's responsibility to ensure the vehicle is loaded correctly and within the vehicle specifications;
- No passengers are to be conveyed on trailers.
